DIRECTIONS:

North to South off I-5

I-5 TO OR-217/KRUSE WAY exit (#292) Turn LEFT (east) onto KRUSE WAY. Kruse Way ends at LOWER BOONES FERRY RD. Turn RIGHT onto LOWER BOONES FERRY RD.

Three tenths of a mile and turn left into **SHON TAY PROFESSIONAL CENTER.***

South to North off I-5
