## **RANKING**

Applicants will be ranked by a score developed from the following: Verifiable documentation is required, letters from employers on company letterhead, DD 214, course certificates, school transcripts, etc.

1. High School Diploma 5 points max.
2. GED 3 points max.
3. Courses that require following written directions to complete projects (drafting, blueprint reading, pattern making design, etc.) 1 point per semester 10 points max.
4. Work Experience:
  - Construction related experience: 2 points per 1000 hours 10 points max.
  - Industry related experience: 5 points per 1000 hours 10 points max.
  - General work experience: 1 per 1000 hours 10 points max.
5. Military experience with Honorable Discharge, Peace Corp Vista: 2 points per year 10 points max.
6. Completion of preparatory program B-Fit, Job Corp or equivalent (other programs will be evaluated and assessed) 10 points max.
7. Valid Drivers License 3 points
