**PAINTER APPRENTICE WAGE INFORMATION**

**Effective April 1, 2010**

**These are the minimum wages that are to be paid to painter apprentices based on the average wage of \$18.21 per hour. Employers may not take benefits out of these wages but may take out school tuition and book fees (\$52.50 per month).**

<b>1<sup>st</sup> period</b>	<b>60%</b>	<b>\$10.93</b>
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> period</b>	<b>65%</b>	<b>11.84</b>
<b>3<sup>rd</sup> period</b>	<b>70%</b>	<b>12.75</b>
<b>4<sup>th</sup> period</b>	<b>75%</b>	<b>13.66</b>
<b>5<sup>th</sup> period</b>	<b>80%</b>	<b>14.57</b>
<b>6<sup>th</sup> period</b>	<b>90%</b>	<b>16.39</b>

**Apprentice wages are determined yearly from an average wage of journeymen working for all training agents in this program.**

**Some journeymen may be making more than the average wage and some journeymen may be making less. When you have completed the program and become a journeyman, depending on your knowledge, ability, attitude, dependability, etc., your wage may be more or less than the average wage. Your employer will determine what wage you are to receive after you complete. The state of Oregon only has requirements for apprentice wages.**
